



**Professor Garry Warne, AM** graduated in Medicine from the University of Melbourne in 1968. He is the Director of Royal Children's Hospital International (RCHI) and a Senior Endocrinologist at the Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne. He first visited Vietnam in 1995 and has made over 40 visits since. Currently RCHI is providing a 3-year Education and Training Project at the National Hospital of Pediatrics in Hanoi and a 5-year cardiovascular training project at Hue Central Hospital. RCHI also participated in a 3-year development and reconstruction project in Aceh following the 2004 Asian tsunami. Professor Warne's clinical career has focused on disorders of sex development and adrenal disorders of childhood. He was awarded the People's Health Medal by the Vietnamese Ministry of Health in 2005 and was made a Member of the Order of Australia in 2010.
