

Dr. Sohee Park, Ph.D., is a biostatistician, serving as the Head of Division of Cancer Registration and Surveillance of National Cancer Center in Korea. She is currently the deputy director of the Korea Central Cancer Registry, a nationwide population-based cancer registry system in Korea, that covers the entire Korean population sized 48 million people. She has been developing various statistical models for predicting cancer incidence and mortality rates in Korea. She is the principal investigator of the project on estimating the number of cancer incident cases and deaths in Korea that are attributable to risk factors such as smoking, alcohol, obesity, reproductive factors, environment and occupation. She has been also collaborating with many cancer experts by providing statistical expertise on subjects involving clinical and epidemiological studies.
