



**Dr Jacek Gajewski** works as a Secretary General of the Central and Eastern European Networking Association (CEENet) and at Physics Faculty of Warsaw University, the cradle of Polish Internet. Dr Gajewski holds a Ph.D. from Warsaw in High Energy Physics from Warsaw University and Dr. H. c. from Nakhchivan State University. Dr Gajewski was a co-author of the first Polish application to BITNET and the petition to President G. Bush to lift COCOM restrictions. He was a Head of Faculty Computer Center, where first Polish: - e-journal, IP LAN, international TCP/IP link, WWW & Usenet servers were created. He carried various EC, NATO and OSI-funded ICT projects. Co-chairman of circa 20 international conferences and training workshops, many related to distance education. Together with Prof. Stella Atkins worked on telemedicine projects in Central Asia. Member of Internet Society, founder of ISOC-Poland. Co-author of 70 articles. Winner of G7 jury ICT award, decorated with the Golden Cross of Merit for Internet development.
