



Dr. Shuji Shimizu, M.D. Ph.D. is surgeon, majoring in endoscopic surgery, which is sometimes called “keyhole operation” and is patient-friendly. But currently Dr Shimizu works more in the project of telemedicine which started between Korea-Japan in 2002.
